CTH BB (STH 25 – Red Cedar River Bridge) Project Information 2012

The Dunn County Highway Department plans to begin road work on CTH BB from STH 25 to the Red Cedar River Bridge (see map below) on Monday 04/02/2012.

This work will consist of culvert maintenance/replacements, ditching/drainage improvements, intersection improvements, concrete box culvert improvements, adding base course, pulverizing the existing roadway, grading, paving, shouldering, and pavement markings. The new roadway will consist of 30ft of hot mix asphalt pavement with 2ft base course shoulders. The work on this project is planned to be completed within the existing road right-of-way. Landowners adjacent to this section of CTH BB should be advised that there will be work done on the existing driveways to match into the new roadway. Also, any mailbox that does not have the appropriate offset from the roadway and/or height will be relocated to meet current standards.

The project is estimated to take 4-6 weeks depending on the weather and other site conditions. The roadway will be open to traffic with a flagging operation during the project, but expect delays if traveling on this route. Please reduce speed and drive with caution through the construction zone. If possible, use an alternate route to avoid using this section of CTH BB while the project is being completed. We ask for everyone's patience and courtesy while the work is being completed on this roadway.
