## RESOLUTION No. 2016-3 Resolution Changing Number of Election Officials (Replaces Resolution #1-2003)

WHEREAS, Section 7.32, Wis. Stats., allows a municipal governing body to reduce the required number of election officials at a polling place from seven (7) in a municipality where voting machines are used to no less than 3, and the town board has determined that it would be advantageous to the town to have only as many election officials on duty as are needed for a given election.

THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Red Cedar, Dunn County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and declares as follows:

There shall be a minimum of three (3) election officials on duty at every election. At the discretion of the town clerk, the requisite number of election officials may be increased for any election. However, the number of election officials working at a given election shall always be an odd number.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.

Adopted this 18<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2016, by a majority vote of the Town Board.
