ORDINANCE NO. 95- 0404

COPY

The Town Board of the Town of Red Cedar, Dunn County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

PARKING ON TOWN ROADS AND TOWN RIGHTS OF WAY REGULATED

It shall be unlawful for the owner operator of any motor vehicle, as defined in Sec. 340.01 Wis. Stats., to store such vehicle on a Town Road. A person shall be deemed to be using the Town Road for storage whenever they shall park a vehicle thereon for a continuous period of eight (8) hours or more.

PENALTIES

An owner or operator who fails to comply with this ordinance shall forfeit \$25.00 for the first violation and \$50.00 for the second and each subsequent violation occurring within a twelve (12) month period.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as provided by Law.
