RESOLUTION NO. 1001-2011 IN THE TOWN OF RED CEDAR

RESOLUTION AMENDING WARD PLAN

The purpose of this resolution is to adjust ward boundaries to accommodate the 2010 Federal Census data and the Dunn County tentative supervisory district plan pursuant to Section 5.15 Wis. Stats.

The Town Board of the Town of Red Cedar, Dunn County, Wisconsin does hereby ordain as follows:

- Ward 1 Supervisory District 24 shall consist of that part of the Township of Red Cedar lying north of Interstate 94, including that part lying west of the Red Cedar River and north of County Road BB; and, that part of the Township of Red Cedar lying south of Interstate 94, and east of County Road B, and east of 610th Street and north of 490th Avenue;
- Ward 2 Supervisory District 28 shall consist of that part of the Township of Red Cedar easterly and southerly of a line described as follows: beginning at the intersection of the south line of said Red Cedar Township and 570th Street, thence north on 570th Street to County Road J, thence northerly along County Road J to the city limits of the City of Menomonie, thence northerly and easterly along said city limits of the City of Menomonie to County Road B, thence south along County Road B to 610th Street, thence south on 610th Street to 490th Avenue, thence east on 490th Avenue to the east line of said Red Cedar Township (also known as the intersection of 490th Avenue and 649th Street), and being the point of ending of this line; and
- Ward 3 Supervisory District 11 shall consist of that part of the Township of Red Cedar, west of the following described line: beginning at the intersection of the south line of said Township of Red Cedar and 570th Street, thence north on said 570th Street to County Road J, thence northerly on County Road J to the City limits of said City of Menomonie, and being the point of ending of this line.

The above wards remain combined for voting purposes so as to share the common polling place, and such combined wards shall continue to use common ballot boxes and ballots and maintain common election returns for the combined wards at any election for which all officers or referendum questions to be voted on are the same. Further, separate returns shall continue to be maintained for the combined wards at any election, except where separate ballots are required under Section 5.62 and 5.64 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Upon passage, a copy of this Resolution shall be filed with the Town Clerk, who shall transmit a copy of this Resolution to the County Clerk within five days of its adoption.

This Resolution shall remain in effect for each election until modified or rescinded, in accordance with Statute, or until a new division is made following the next Federal decennial census.
