# **ORIDINANCE No. 2016-2**

# Ordinance to Adopt Updated Town of Red Cedar Comprehensive Plan

# Section I. TITLE AND PURPOSE

The title of this ordinance is: Ordinance to Adopt Updated Town of Red Cedar Comprehensive Plan.

The Town Board of the Town of Red Cedar, Dunn County, Wisconsin, has authority under its village powers Section II. AUTHORITY under s. 60.22, Wis. Stats., to appoint a town plan commission under ss. 60.62(4) and 62.23(1), Wis. Stats., and under s. 66.1001(4), Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance. The comprehensive plan of the Town of Red Cedar must be in compliance with s. 66.1001(4)(c), Wis. Stats., in order for the town board to adopt this ordinance.

## Section III. ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the adoption by the town of a comprehensive plan under s. 66.1001(4), Wis. Stats.

Section IV. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION The town board has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in every stage of the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by s. 66.1001(4)(a), Wis. Stats.

## Section V. TOWN PLAN COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION

The Plan Commission of the Town of Red Cedar, by a majority vote of the entire commission, recorded in its official minutes, has adopted a resolution recommending to the town board the adoption of the updated "Comprehensive Plan For The Town of Red Cedar", which contains all of the elements specified in s. 66.1001(2), Wis. Stats.

### Section VI. PUBLIC HEARING

The Town of Red Cedar has held at least one public hearing on this ordinance, with notice in compliance with the requirements of s. 66.1001(4)(d), Wis. Stats.

# Section VII. ADOPTION OF UPDATED TOWN COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

The town board, by the enactment of this ordinance, formally adopts the document entitled "Comprehensive Plan For The Town of Red Cedar" under s. 66.1001(4)(c), Wis. Stats.

### Section VIII. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

### **Section IX. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats., and a copy of the ordinance and the comprehensive plan, shall be filed with at least all of the entities specified under s. 66.1001(4)(b), Wis. Stats.
