Ordinance No. 1014-2002  
ELECTRICAL PERMITS

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Red Cedar do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Electrical Permit Required

No electrical wiring or other equipment shall be installed, altered or repaired without first securing an electrical permit from the Town Building Inspector. Such permits shall be issued only to a master electrician certified by the state of Wisconsin or to a property owner who is to personally perform the work on existing premises currently occupied exclusively as residence for himself/herself and his/her immediate family. Such permits shall not be transferable.

Section 2. General Scope

General Scope and Standards for Work; Wiring Methods and Installations. All electrical work shall be performed in conformity with the most recent edition of the national fire protection association "National Electrical Code" and existing modifications of same by the state of Wisconsin electrical code, volume 2.


Section 3. General Regulations


Unless otherwise especially permitted by the inspector, all work shall be left uncovered for examination until examined and approved by the inspector.

Section 4. Effective Date

This ordinance shall be in effect November 1, 2002, following publication as provided by law.
