

**TOWN OF RED CEDAR  
ORDINANCE NO. 1001-2010**

**Ordinance to Lower Speed Limit on Town Highways and Roads**

STATE OF WISCONSIN  
Town of Red Cedar  
Dunn County

The Town Board of the Town of Red Cedar, Dunn County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wisc. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town highways and roads in the town as follows:

A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. Stats., effective July 1, 2010, speed limits on certain Town of Red Cedar town highways and roads are reduced or modified as follows:

45 MPH ZONE:

1. 571<sup>st</sup> Avenue

25 MPH ZONE:

1. 560<sup>th</sup> Street
2. 690<sup>th</sup> Avenue
3. 550<sup>th</sup> Street
4. 680<sup>th</sup> Avenue

B. Pursuant to s. 349.11(5), Wis. Stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways and roads in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. Stats.

This ordinance is effective on July 1, 2010.

The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wisc. Stats.
