2021 ANNUAL TOWN MEETING OF ELECTORS

APRIL 20, 2021

6:30 P.M.

- 1) CALL TO ORDER. At 6:30 p.m., the Town Chairman, Bob Cook, called the meeting to order. Present were 10 residents, including the Town Chair, Supervisors 1, 2, and 3, and the Clerk and Treasurer.
- 2) REVIEW AND APPROVE PRIOR YEAR'S MINUTES (2020 ANNUAL MEETING). *Motion by Deb Gotlibson to approve the prior year's minutes; motion seconded by Jim Richartz. None opposed. MC*
- 3) REVIEW AND APPROVE THE 2020 (YEAR-END) FINANCIAL REPORT. The Clerk and Treasurer reviewed the financial report with those present. *Motion by Jim Richartz to approve the 2020 Financial Report; motion seconded by Don Hayden. None opposed. MC*
- 4) DISCUSSION ITEMS for review and possible action:
 - (a) Hourly rate for Town Supervisor to perform required and necessary duties as the authorized agent of the Responsible Unit's garbage and recycling program. *Motion by Don Hayden to set the hourly rate at \$20.00 per hour for a Town Supervisor to perform the required and necessary duties as the Town's authorized agent of the Responsible Unit's garbage and recycling program; motion seconded by Dottie Hayden. None opposed. MC*
 - (b) Any other business presented by town residents. Discussion was had on the purchase of the 4-ton unit heated trailer for blacktop, hired out brush cutting services, the yard waste disposal site, the possible purchase of a tractor broom to sweep roads (Jim Richartz will look into new and used options), the purchase of a new dump/plow truck to replace the 2009 International, work performed to the Town shop, our ATV Ordinance/time frame roads are open, hours of operation, speed (will be revisited at our May town board meeting), 2021 road projects, and water issues on Kettner Lane. Residents present thanked the town board for all the hard work they perform for the town and residents.
- 5) SET NEXT ANNUAL MEETING DATE. The next Annual Meeting date was set for April 19, 2022 (Third Tuesday) at 6:30 p.m.
