

TOWN OF RED CEDAR ORDINANCE AMENDMENT NO. 2022-1
(Amending Town Ordinance 2014-1 ATV/UTV Route – 6th Amendment)

The Town Board of the Town of Red Cedar, Dunn County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance amendment is to extend the Town's approved ATV/UTV route and open all roads to use for a temporary period ending on January 31, 2023.

SECTION II. AMENDMENT

Section 5 of the ordinance is amended as follows (added language is underlined):

SECTION 5 – DESIGNATION OF ALL-TERRAIN AND UTILITY-TASK VEHICLE ROUTES

The Town has agreed to open all town roads to use to all-terrain and utility-task vehicles for a temporary period expiring on January 31, 2023.

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this Ordinance or any application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or unconstitutional, such a finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.

SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE


This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.




