



Spring/Summer - 2023 Yard Waste Disposal Information

Town of Red Cedar residents may drop off materials at the Yard Waste Disposal Site located at **N5106 610th Street** (approximately one mile south of the intersection of Hwy. 12/29 and County Highway B/610th Street) at the top of the hill on the east side of the road. Look for the yellow gates. Be prepared to furnish proof of residence: i.e. driver's license.

Dates and Hours

- Saturday, April 15 – 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
 - Wednesday, April 26 – 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
 - Saturday, May 6 – 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
 - Wednesday, May 10 – 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
 - Saturday, May 20 – 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
 - Wednesday, May 24 – 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
 - Wednesday, June 7 – 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
 - Wednesday, July 5 – 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
 - Wednesday, August 2 – 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Additional dates and times may be added for fall drop off*

ACCEPTABLE Items to Bring to the Site:

- Yes – Biodegradable Paper Bags
- Yes – Brush Under 4" Diameter and 12' Length
- Yes – Grass Clippings, Leaves, Pine Needles, and Garden Plants
- Yes – Christmas Trees (NO ARTIFICIAL)

The Following Items are NOT Accepted:

- No – Building or Landscape Materials
- No – Dirt
- No – Food, Animal, or Household Waste
- No – Metal or Appliances
- No – Plastic Bags or Planters
- No – Rocks, Pavers, Bricks, Ceramic, Glass, or Boulders
- No – Painted, Stained, or Treated Wood (Timbers, Wood Chips, RR Ties, Etc.)
- No – Trees, Stumps, Brush Over 4" Diameter and 12' Length

When unloading, separate grass clippings/leaves from woody brush materials and dispose of in the designated areas.

Wood chips are available for pick up at no charge during open hours. Hand load only – no machines. NOT for commercial use.

As a reminder, this site is to be used by the residents of the Town of Red Cedar to dispose of yard waste.
