

Minutes - TOWN OF RED CEDAR

The Town Board of the Town of Red Cedar met on Saturday, April 15, 2023 at the Town Hall, E6591 627th Avenue, Menomonie, WI.

Call to Order: The Road Inspection meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Bob Cook at 9:10 a.m. Also in attendance were Supervisor 1, Erik Hendrickson; Supervisor 2, Jim Richartz; Supervisor 3, Don Hayden; the Treasurer, Deb Gotlibson; and the Town Patrolman, Jeff Kistner.

Business:

- 1) The board members left the town hall to inspect town roads at 9:10 a.m.
- 2) The road inspection was completed at 11:45 a.m., and board members commenced the meeting at the Exit 45 Restaurant Meeting Room in Menomonie. Supervisor 4, Nick Berends, and the Clerk, Cheryl Miller, attended this portion of the meeting.

The Town Board discussed fund availability for road projects and requested that these projects be placed on the agenda for review at the next monthly board meeting. Items of note discussed and/or acted upon are documented below:

Priority Projects/Preferred.

- 1) 640th Avenue, east of CTH E – **crack fill** culvert area seam between 2 sections of pavement and possible **spray patch** between old and new sections of pavement (about 150' to 200') or 1 mile.
- 2) 740th Street, north of CTH E – **spray patch** ½ mile from CTH E north to the first corner.
- 3) 650th Avenue, between CTH B and CTH E – **crack fill or chip seal**.
- 4) 610th Street, from the yard waste disposal site south – **crack fill**, shoulder work.
- 5) 610th Avenue, between CTH B and CTH E – **crack fill**.
- 6) 567th Street, north of 490th Avenue – **spray patch** trench in middle of road.

Other Projects

- 1) 720th Avenue, just west of Hoffman Hills entrance – future bridge/LRIP project.
- 2) 690th Avenue, east of CTH B – grader patch on top of hill.
- 3) 574th Street near Cedar Falls – look into removing trees at the end of the road.
- 4) 568th Street/689th Avenue near Cedar Falls – remove gate (safety and snow plowing issues), or look into discontinuing alley/road.
- 5) 689th Avenue – remove and haul away excess dirt along road edge.
- 6) 650th Avenue, Eagle Point – patch pot holes and grader patch.
- 7) 649th Street, east of 610th Street – grinding, crushed rock/recycled black top.
- 8) 550th Avenue, between 610th Street and CTH E – leave crushed rock between Holden and Mars residences.

Adjournment. At 2:15 p.m., the Town Chairman, Bob Cook, adjourned the meeting without objection.
